

## **Description:**

The Natu Blanket Wrap is an oversized shawl/wrap in neutral colors which give a timeless feel. This crochet pattern features a variety of stitches including a step by step tutorial on how to make vertical stripes.

#### **Materials:**

- 4.0mm crochet hook
- Lion Brand Yarn Heartland in three colors:
  - A. Mammoth 4 balls
  - B. Grand Canyon 3 balls
  - C. Katmai 1 ball
- Scissors
- Tapestry needle to weave in ends

#### Sizes:

One size

## Gauge:

4''x4'' = 17 st x 10 rows using vertical stripes (alternating colors R16-R25)

## **Finished Sweater Measurements:**

Height- 26.5

Length - 66.5

## **Pattern Notes:**

- 1. Special stitches and techniques for changing yarn and different stitches are available at the end of the pattern. Pictures at this section are made using different yarn and hook size to better contrast and show stitches
- 2. Alternating colors differ in technique for right and wrong side of the wrap, refer to stitch explanations.

# Pattern

## Color A

Ch 251

**Row 1-3** -dc into third ch from hook (this serves as your first and second dc), dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

Switch to C

Row 4 – hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

Switch to A

Row 5-6 – dc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

Row 7 - alternate between A and C hdc (250 sts) \*Refer to special stitches if needed

Switch to A

Row 8-9 - dc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

Switch to C

Row 10 - hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

Switch to A

Row 11- hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

Switch to B

R12- hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

**R13** - dc into third ch from hook, dc in next 3, bobble, \*dc in next 9, bobble. Repeat from \* to end, dc in remaining 5 st. (250 sts)

R14 - hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

Switch to A

R15 - hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

**R16-25** — alternate stripes in dc between A and B (250 sts) \*Refer to special stitches if needed

Drop B and keep A

R26 - hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

Switch to B

R27- hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

**R28** - dc into third ch from hook, dc in next 3, bobble, \*dc in next 9, bobble. Repeat from \* to end, dc in remaining 5 st. (250 sts)

R29 - hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

Switch to A

R30 - hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

Switch to C

R31 – hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

Switch to A

R32-33 – dc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

R34 – alternate between A and C hdc (250 sts) \*Refer to special stitches if needed

Switch to A

R35-36 - dc into third ch from book dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

Pattern

#### Switch to A

R35-36 - dc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

#### Switch to C

R37 – hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

## Switch to A

R38 - hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

## Switch to B

R39- hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

**R40** - dc into third ch from hook, dc in next 3, bobble, \*dc in next 9, bobble. Repeat from \* to end, dc in remaining 5 st. (250 sts)

R41 - hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

## Switch to A

R42 - hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

R43-52 — alternate stripes in dc between A and B (250 sts) \*Refer to special stitches if needed

## Drop B and continue with A

R53 - hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

## Switch to B

R54 -hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

**R55** - dc into third ch from hook, dc in next 3, bobble, \*dc in next 9, bobble. Repeat from \* to end, dc in remaining 5 st. (250 sts)

R56 - hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

## Switch to A

R57 - hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

## Switch to C

R58- hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

#### Switch to A

R59-60 – dc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

R61 – alternate between A and C hdc (250 sts) \*Refer to special stitches if needed

## Switch to A

R62-63 - dc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

## Switch to C

R64 – hdc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

#### Switch to A

R65-66 - dc into third ch from hook, dc in next 248 ch (250 sts)

### Fasten off

# **Abbreviations (US Terms):**

Ch - chain

Dc – double crochet

Hdc – half double crochet

Yo – yarn over

St/s – stitch/es

R-row

Note: To change colors, pull through with next color to finish previous stitch. See picture below









# Alternate Stitches

**Right side of the project (odd rows)** work stitches while holding alternate color above top row as if weaving in. See pictures below



Wrong side (even rows) drop color between stitches as you work and continue with stitch until you need to change color. Drop working color over new color and pull through



## 2. Bobble Stitch

Yarn over, insert into stitch, yarn over and pull through chain (3 loops on hook), yarn over pull through 2 loops Repeat process until you have 5 loops on your hook. Yarn over, pull through 5 loops. This is one bobble stitch.
